

Behiye-Dr. Nevhiz Işıl Primary School, which carried out a Comenius project called “A Journey Around the Mediterranean” between 2010-2012 successfully, has just undertaken a new Erasmus+ project this year.

The project called “P.L.A.C.E.S : Presenting Legends Across the Continents in European Schools” which is supported by The Republic of Turkey The Ministry of European Union and European Commission, has been started in September 2015 with the cooperation of nine different countries (Turkey, Croatia, Bulgaria, Italy, Germany, Romania, Slovakia, Cyprus and Greece). It aims to create a common European cultural heritage by scrutinizing each partners’ myths, tales and legends. With this project, we are trying to combine past, present and the future together.

By the grant given by the Turkish National Agency, the teachers of our school had the chance to visit the school named “Osnovna Skola Marije i Line” located in Umag/Croatia between 04-08 November 2015 as the first step of the project. During this visit, they had the chance to witness and search the education system of the school and watched the programme prepared by the students of host school. By this way, the mutual cultural interaction has started. Apart from that, with the visit and cultural trip at weekend prepared by host school gave our teachers insight to explore a different cultural heritage.
